St George's Church Bonus Ball Competition Rules

The Bonus Ball competition will be a regular fundraiser for St George's Church and will be administered by the Bonus Ball Competition Organiser. (Allan Underhill; Tel: 01743 243448; e-mail: AEUnderhill@meifod.fsbusiness.co.uk)

The competition will commence on the first Saturday in September (6th September) 2014.

Balls numbered 1 to 49 are available for sale at £1 per week. Initially, an individual may purchase up to five balls.

PAYMENT: £13 per quarter, payable by standing order, initially on the following date:

1 September 2014 and quarterly thereafter. **Forms to be returned by Sunday, 10 August 2014**, (see entry form). Subsequently people may join on the first of any following month having returned the form by the 10th of the previous month.

PRIZE MONEY: One prize of £24.50 per week or 50% of entry money collected for that week, whichever is the lower figure.

- The winning bonus ball number will be taken from each Saturday's National Lottery Draw commencing on 6 Sept. 2014.
- The holder of the number drawn will win the prize for that week.
- Players will be advised of their allocated number and the list of players' numbers will be displayed on the Church notice board.
- If the winning ball has not been bought, half of the prize money will be retained by the Church and the other half will be rolled over to the next draw.
- All prizes will be issued the week following the draw and the list of winners displayed quarterly in arrears on the church notice board.

Additional Rules

1. The Bonus Ball shall run all year round, a minimum of 25 balls must be sold to enable the scheme to run. More than one bonus ball competition may run at any one time.
2. One person shall be allocated to each number and each number costs £1 per week, multiple ball allocation up to five balls is permitted.
3. The winning ball shall be that of the bonus ball that is drawn in the National Lottery draw on Saturday nights.
4. For a ball to be eligible to win a prize, payment must have been received in advance.
5. If a person's ball is drawn and the appropriate payment money has not been received, then that person will not be eligible to collect the winnings and a rollover will incur.
6. Continued non-payment for a ball will result in the ball being available to be re-sold.
7. If more than 49 people want to join the scheme a waiting list will operate unless and until 25 or more names are available to start a further competition.
8. Balls are allocated on a first come first served basis.
9. The Bonus ball Competition organiser reserves the right to refuse pay out if one or more of the rules above are not complied with and his/her word is final.
10. The Bonus Ball Competition organiser is not paid and may enter the competition if he/she wishes.
11. Participation in this competition will be open to members, relatives, friends and supporters of St George's Church.
12. Participants must be over the age of 16.
13. The viability of running the Bonus Ball Competition will be reviewed quarterly.
